Running a business comes with many responsibilities, including staying **compliant** with **state** and **federal laws**. To help you avoid common pitfalls, we've put together this essential checklist. Save this as a quick reference to safeguard your operations and ensure **peace of mind**:



Business Entity Compliance

- Ensure you've filed an annual Public Information Report and franchise tax returns with the Texas Comptroller.
- Maintain an updated Operating Agreement (LLCs) or Bylaws (Corporations).



Employment Law Essentials

- Display all required labor law posters in the workplace.
- Ensure compliance with worker classification rules (independent contractors vs. employees).
- Have written employment agreements or policies that outline expectations and protect your interests.



Contracts & Agreements

 Regularly review contracts with vendors, clients, and partners for enforceability.



Cybersecurity & Data Protection

- Implement a data breach response plan in compliance with the Texas Data Breach Notification Law.
- Use secure methods to store customer and employee data.
- Train employees on cybersecurity best practices, including phishing prevention.



Licensing & Permits

- Verify all required state and local permits and licenses are up-todate (e.g., sales tax permits, professional licenses).
- Conduct periodic checks to ensure compliance with industryspecific regulations.
